Background/Overview

- Law requires pesticide use reporting
- Passed in 1999, partially implemented 2002-2003, funding re-instated 2005, retains sunset date of 2009
- All web-based reporting at direction of Oregon Legislature

Funding

- 2005 Oregon Legislature fully funded PURS for the 2005-2007 biennium
 - Approximately \$800,000 per biennium
- Half from annual pesticide product registration fee (\$40)
- Half from “General Funds”

Who Must Report?

- Any person who uses or applies a pesticide:
 - In the course of business
 - For a government entity
 - In a location that is intended for public use or access

Who Must Report?

- Agriculture
- Forestry
- Government Agencies
 - Federal, State, County, City, Public Schools, Other Public Districts
- Utility Companies
- Pest Control Companies
- Landlords / Managers of:
 - Residential Properties, Hotels, Motels
Business Properties, Restaurants, Stores, etc.

Who Must File Reports?

- The employer of the individual(s) who applies the pesticides
- Applications made by Commercial Pesticide Operator are Reported by that Commercial Pesticide Operator

Changes to PURS

- **SB 290 - 2005**
 - **Location**
 - **ZIP code**
 - **Water basin**
 - **Greater confidentiality**
 - **2 separate databases**
 - **More generalized specific sites**

Reporting Locations

- ZIP code
 - Urban/general indoor
 - Urban/general outdoor

- Water basin
 - Agriculture
 - Aquatic
 - Forestry
 - Public health/regulatory pests
 - Right-of-way
 - Research
 - Other

OAR 603-057-0413

(7) Urban, general indoor sites. This shall include the use of pesticides inside dwellings, non- agricultural buildings, establishments, institutions, schools and commercial transportation vehicles. This shall also include the use of pesticides on commodities, including agricultural commodities stored indoors that have entered into channels of commerce, including commercial warehouses and commercial grain elevators.

(8) Urban, general outdoor sites. This shall include the use of pesticides outside dwellings, non- agricultural buildings, establishments, institutions, or schools for ornamental and turf pest control, including parks, rest areas, and golf courses. This shall also include the use of pesticides on commodities, including agricultural commodities stored outdoors that have entered into channels of commerce.

Registration Database

Registration information is maintained in a separate database from pesticide use data

- You provide:
 - Name
 - Address
 - Phone
 - Contact information
- System Generates:
 - Unique Reporter ID Number
 - Password

What Must Be Reported?

- All registered pesticides (both restricted & general use) including:
 - Herbicides
 - Insecticides
 - Fungicides
 - Defoliants, Plant Regulators, etc.
 - BUT NOT Antimicrobials (NOT reportable)
- Includes special registrations and experimental use products

What Must Be Reported?

- **Date of Application**
 - Month, Day and Year
- **Type of Site Category & Specific Site:**
 - **Agriculture**
 - Field Crops
 - Fruits/Nuts
 - Livestock/Poultry
 - Nursery/Christmas Trees
 - Oil Crops
 - Pasture/Forage/Hay
 - Seed Crops
 - Vegetables
 - Other

What Must Be Reported?

- Urban/General Indoor
 - Dwelling/Residence
 - Site with Non-Public Access
 - Site with Public Access
 - Other
- Urban/General Outdoor
 - Site association with Dwelling/Residence
 - Site with Non-Public Access
 - Site with Public Access
 - Other

What Must Be Reported?

- **Pesticide Product Name**
(Brand name as stated on label)
- **Product Identification Number**
(EPA Registration Number, Oregon SLN Number, Section 18 Number, etc.)

What Must Be Reported?

- Quantity of Undiluted Product Applied
- Purpose of Application
 - Weed control
 - Disease control
 - Insect control
 - Bird control
 - Rodent control
 - Moss control

Aggregation

- All applications made in a single calendar month to the same site category or specific site within the same water basin or ZIP code may be reported on the same report

Ready to Use Products

- Date of use is when product is emptied or disposed
- Quantity is amount stated on label
- Location is the ZIP code or water basin where the container was emptied

Reporting Frequency

- At the minimum, once a year
- Pesticide users must report their pesticide use by January 31st of the following calendar year
 - 2007 data no later than January 31, 2008
- Recommend monthly

Confidentiality

- Specific information reported is confidential, including:
 - Identification of pesticide user, and
 - Information that could identify the pesticide user

What Happens to the Info?

- Annual report
- Special reports -
 - Prepared by ODA in response to requests from local, state or federal agencies or health or environmental researchers
 - Information in reports is about pesticides used - site category, water basin or ZIP code, not who used the pesticide

What is ODA Doing Now?

- Web reporting available now!
- Information on the ODA web site
 - PURS worksheets available
 - Reverse directory under “Finding a site for reporting”
 - County-by-county water basin maps
 - EDS documents
- Hands-on help classes being planned

Household Use Survey

- State divided into 9 regions
- Participants obtained through telephone interviews
- Continues each quarter with a new group of participants from each region

Household Use Survey

- Participants complete three month pesticide use diary
- Information gathered is the same as from pesticide users filing reports
- Information also included in the PURS Annual Report
