NEW LAW AFFECTS ALL PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

Do you work for or contract with a school? Beginning July 1, 2012 a Pesticide Applicator license will be required for every pesticide application, regardless of who makes it. This includes applying weed control products with a backpack sprayer and applying over-the-counter pesticides like wasp sprays or ant bait in ready-to-use packages. There are also unique requirements for monitoring and recording.
